It is little more than 10 minutes easy drive into Tewantin village and that much again to Noosa main beach.

River stone clings to the rendered front boundary fence, while either side of this a spectacular circular asphalt driveway has dual

automatic gate access and a touchpad security pedestrian approach. The driveway also provides straight line access to a massive shed for vehicles and machinery fully set up with its own bathroom,

three phase power, solar roof panels and fully operational gym. This shed will more than accommodate larger special utility vehicles.

A mature Canary Island date palm stands proudly in the grassed forecourt where it perfectly frames the raised roof port cochere and the elegant form of the main entry. This immaculately prepared and very intelligently wired home has been tailored to perfection with the design savvy of local architect Paul Hinds.

From the vestibule entry marble tiled floors in a mirror like finish introduce you to an exceptionally well detailed formal dining room with timber accents. A diagonally situated family music room echoes to the refrain of a baby grand and is warmed by a wall mounted gas Jetmaster fireplace.

Stone benchtops anchor this wall



mounted display of touch operated cabinets and blum soft-closing drawers. Function meets beauty at every turn.

It continues out through superbly crafted timber framed stacker and bi-fold doors that engage outdoor pavilion living across marble floors A built-in outdoor kitchen with stone benches along one wall caters to alfresco dining, while the focal point pool sweeps its way past a raised pavilion where you can bubble away the seasons in a large spa that sits flush against the deep stain of timber decking.

The use of American and Queensland walnut serves to beautifully accent an array of living domains, while down one wing of the home are exceptionally well prepared children's bedrooms and a private guest suite. This beautifully prepared suite has been equipped with kitchenette and enjoys direct access to the pool court and stunning grounds.

The tall screen of hedging along the boundaries and the wide lawn buffer to a forest backdrop provide wonderful privacy across gardens and entertaining areas.

Set away in the other wing and past a sweetly placed window seat, a fabulous home cinema room takes viewing latest release movies to another level. A

completely elegant home office has a subtle connection to the garden terraces. The sublime main bedroom and sleekly styled ensuite deliver a five-star standard of luxury with casual anlomb.

Rich wallpaper lends an air of glamour to this indulgently large bedroom, while a striking ensuite with chandelier has a centre stage spa bath to a walk through shower and twin vanities set either side of floor to ceiling tiled walls.
